- (C) IT IS THE MOST POPULANCE CITY APART FROM THE 9 PROVINCES.
- (D) POPULATION ARISES MORE THAN 100,00 PLUS AS PER LATEST POPULATION CENSIS IN 2019.
- (E) REFERED TO AS THE MOST CHALLENGING ENVIRONMENT IN VIEW OF THE MANY ETHNIC GROUPINGS.
- (F) WHERE ALL SOLOMON ISLANDS WANT TO BE.

INTRODUCTION

- SIX (6) UNITS;
- ACCOMODATING ALL FIELD WORKERS INVOLVED IN ALL WASTE MANAGEMENT OPERATIONS; THIS INCLUDES:
- (A) COMPACTOR DRIVERS
- (B) COLLECTION VEHICLES CREWS
- (C) TIP CONTROL WORKERS
- (D) STREET CLEANERS
- (E) DESLUDGING SERVICES
- (F) OTHER FIELD WORKERS

AIM:

THE OVERALL AIM IS TO COORDINATE, MANAGE AND UNDERTAKEN ALL MEASURES NECESSARY TO ENSURE THAT HONIARA CITY IS A LIVEABLE AND HEALTHY CITY.

OVERALL OBJECTIVES:

- (3) WORLD BANK CAUSE PATNERSHIP WITH HCC;
- (4) MECDM RELATED WORK ACTIVITIES ALSO (PLASTIC BAN, AWARENESS, ETC.);
- (5) AUSAID WASTE RECYLING EFFORTS;
- (6) KANTER ADB (EXAMPLE FLOOD WARNINGS)
- (7) SIAF COMMUNITY RELATED ACTIVITIES (SOLOMON ISLANDS ASSITANCE FORCE, EXAMPLE; BURNSCREEK COMMUNITY)
- (8) PRC INPUT THROUGH LOGISTICS;
- (9) USA INTEREST THROUGH LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PUBLIC ORDER UNDERTAKINGS;
- (10) NZ PROPOSED CAPACITY BUILDING UNDERTAKINGS AS WELL.

CHALLENGES:

- (A) CAPACITY BUILDING AND STAFF DEVELOPMENT/ ISSUES;
- (B) LOGISTICAL SUPPORT AND MAN POWER;
- (C) ENFORCEMENT OF LEGISLATIONS AND BYELAWS;
- (D) BEHAVIORAL AND ADDITIONAL SO AS OTHER SOCIO ECONOMICAL FACTORS;
- (E) LACK OF IMPREST ON THE GROUND FOR WASTE RECYCLERS;
- (F) HAMMONIZATION OF DIFFERENT LEGISLATIONS TO AVOID DUPLICATION ISSUES;
- (G) BUDGETORY SUPPORT IS LACKING AND NOT FORTHCOMING AS WELL;
- (H) CHANGE OF MINDSET / WILL DIVERSE (POLITICAL WILL);
- (I) CONDUSIVE ENVIRONMENT.

SUGGESTED CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

- (A) CHANGE IN BAHAVIOR AND ATTITUDE ON THE PART OF CITIZENS;
- (B) INSURANCE IN BUDGET SUPPORT;
- (C) DONOR PARTNERS SUPPORT IN TERMS OF BUILDING CAPACITY IS ALSO CRITICAL;
- (D) REVIEW OF LEGISLATIONS TO ADDRESS GAPS;
- (E) SUPPORT IN TERMS OF WASTE RECYCLERS AND WASTE PICKERS;
- (F) AWARENESS PROGRAMS TO BE REVIEWED AND IMPROVED SO AS OTHER SUSTAINABLE PROGRAMS;
- (G) INCENTIVES FOR STAFF AND WORKERS;
- (H) LAND AND HOUSING MATTERS (INFORMAL SETTLEMENTS).
